"When we designed this space we wanted to make sure that we gave all of our residents, from young families to fitness fanatics, something to enjoy well into the future," said Mr Greaves.

Mr Greaves added that the combination of resort style living, selected city view blocks and the proximity to wetlands, coastal park and beach are proving major selling points.

"Saltwater Coast is much more than a house and land package. It's a place where families want to build premium homes in an idyllic location," Colin said.
